- Mardie gave quick updates on upcoming 2015 Regional Conferences. Please let Mardie know if you will be attending.
- Mardie updated group on change to AFA 2014 dates. Will be December 2-6 in Nashville, TN.

AFA 2013: **Mardie**

- Over 200 people attended the reception in 2013.
- Cost \$5,000. We are seeing a steady increase in audio/visual costs.
- Case Study Competition:
 - Switched to two (2) tracks in 2013; systemic issues and crisis intervention.
 - \$1,200 was awarded in 2013 AFA Case Study Competition.

2015 Summer Board Meeting: **David**

Outstanding Professional Awards: **Mardie**

- This year, RCD's were given task of looking at campus staff members that have served their respective Fraternity/Sorority communities in an outstanding manner.
- After list was generated, HQ Staff helped to select the winners of this category. Four (4) professional staff members were selected to receive a \$1,000 honorarium at the Regional Conferences.
- How else can we select the recipients? (Discussion tabled for Saturday)

Technology Report: **Kent P**

- Servers at HQ were updated in 2012-2013.
- Website Update:
 - Kent P discussed timeline of new website platform through GIN Systems.
 - Next step is to find a responsive design (i.e. a site that works well across computers, tablets, mobile phones, etc)
- Kent P updated group on our online merchandise sales platform move from Google to Shopify in November 2013. Google discontinued their platform so we had to find a new point of sale website.
- Kent P states that we will need to seriously discuss future costs for technology as it evolves and becomes much more prevalent.

Sponsored Programs: **Mardie**

- 2013 saw an increase in money given out. We gave out \$96,000 to various programs.
- In 2013, Order of Omega sponsored the SEPC Emerging Leaders program (\$2,500).
- Not included in this are the items donated to the AFA Silent Auction.

New and Reactivated Chapters: **Mike**

- In 2013-2014, we had 11,243 new initiates (from 6-26-13 to 7-1-14).
- Total Chapters to date: 545 (473 active)
- New chapters: 6 | Reactivated Chapters: 8
- Membership by Regions:
 - Western – 3,424
 - Southern – 3,125
 - Mid-America – 2,609
 - Northeast – 2,104

Office Renovation report: **Mardie**

- Headquarters had stairs installed to access the 2nd floor attic area. Cost was \$8,370 for stairs, new carpet, doors, and additional lighting.
- Project was completed in January of 2014.
- Regular building maintenance is needed after 7 years.
- Mardie will be having the contractors come up with a quote for a building maintenance plan.

Lot Development report: **Mardie**

- We were notified in May of 2013 that an apartment complex is slated to be built on land adjacent to headquarters building.
- There is a property (sing family housing) valued at \$46,000 directly behind headquarters. If it came up for sale, would we think about buying it?

AFA Scholarship: **Mardie**

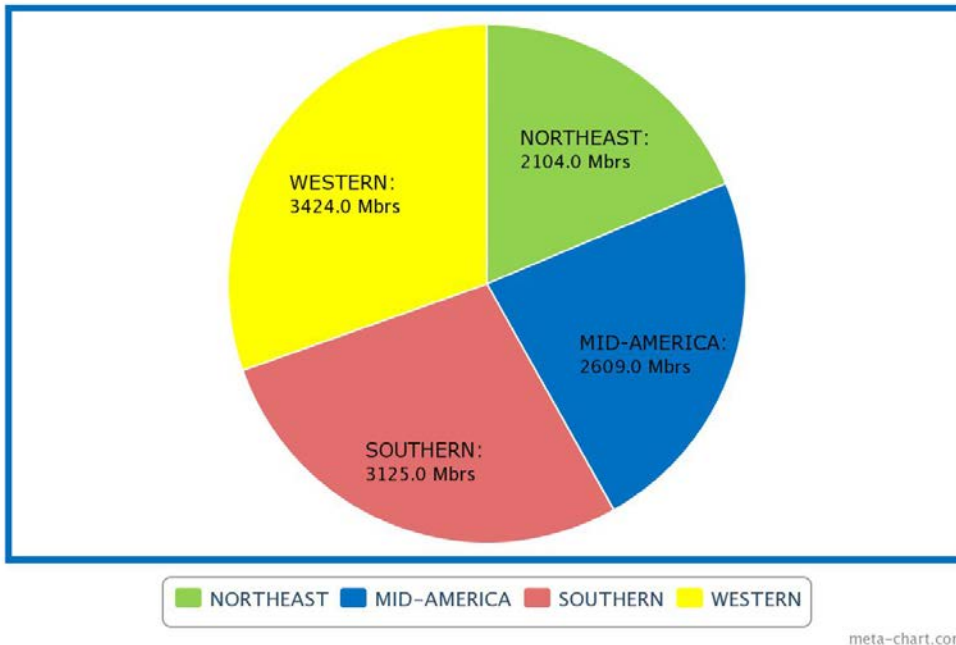
- We have sponsored two (2) Graduate scholarships to attend AFA (\$240 each). We have been asked to continue this sponsorship level.

 - **Motion seconded and all vote YES.**
 - **Motion passes.**

Scholarship/Fellowship Report: **Reatha**

- In 2014-2015 Doctoral money will be \$2,000
- In 2014-2015 Master's Fellowship money will be \$1,000
- Highlights were reviewed and will be available on website.

Outstanding Chapter Awards: **Mardie**

- Only received six (6) applications in 2013-2014
- --Discussion on how we can increase number of applications--
- Idea to have RCD's nominate chapters and said chapters would have to apply was discussed
- Board recommends RCD's nomination as well as chapters applying
- Idea to highlight chapters that have won previously so that other chapters can see that their efforts are actually within reach (this idea by Jillian Haslett)
- More direct email besides the Fall Letter to chapter Presidents and Advisors



Chapter Concerns: **All**

- Discussed access of membership database for RCD's.
- No other concerns at this time.

HQ Report: **Mardie, Kent G. & Mike**

- Marketing:
 - Continue as is. Continue E-Group partnership.
- Memberships
 - Discussion on membership pins needing to be bigger based on concerns voiced by chapters.
 - Board reviewed sample renditions.
- Membership Pin Vote: **Mardie**
 - **--VOTE--**
 - **All in favor of keeping pin to current size: 3**
 - **All in favor of new 9/16 (medium size): 11**
 - **All in favor of new 5/8th (large size): 4**
 - **Motion to move forward with purchase of the 9/16th medium size passes**
- Merchandise
 - We are currently reviewing merchandise sales.
 - Also reviewing shipping costs, especially Express shipping. Seems like we are taking a hit on shipping costs.
 - E-Group is working with us to update our Graduation Cords and Honor Stoles. Grad cords will include an Omega fob and will be individually packaged.
- Social Media
 - Will be looking for some professional development opportunities in social media.
 - Discussed possibility of having the Student Board Member run social media.
- Omega Investments
 - There was a \$3,000 sales charge for purchasing the Gardner Award but interest is predicted to generate \$2,500 annual to support award.
 - One of the CD's is up for maturity. Mardie proposes taking that to a JP Morgan Chase 5% account instead.
 - **-VOTE-**
 - **Motion to move Chase CD (\$100,000) to a JP Morgan Chase account.**
 - **Motion is seconded, no discussion.**
 - **No opposition, all approve, motion passes.**
