To be eligible for Order of Omega membership consideration, the applicant must satisfy the following minimum standards:

- Must have been enrolled as a student at the University/College for at least one (1) academic year prior to their application.
- Must be a sophomore, junior, or senior at the University/College.
- Must be in good academic standing with the University/College.
- Must be in good standing with their fraternity or sorority, both at the University/College and with their inter/national headquarters, if applicable.

Each applicant may only accumulate 10 points per category with a maximum of 40 points possible.
